

Harrow Carrier Units and Harrow Carts



AerWay® Carrier Units are designed to be practical, durable and easy to use.

The unit base is 2" heavy square tubing mounted to the frame. The 6 foot carriers are easily removed by a single pin.

When the *AerWay*® is down, simply raise the rear of the harrow, secure on the rear hook. Then, lift the front bar of the harrow and secure with the chain.

A three point hitch lift frame is also available.

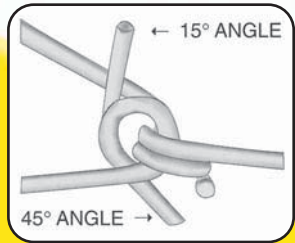
Teeth are provided on both sides.

- 3-inch teeth are angled 45 degrees for better trash harrowing and lighter harrowing action on one side.
- 3-inch teeth are angled 15 degrees on the opposite side for more rigid harrowing action.
- This harrow, because of its unique tooth arrangement, is self-cleaning under most conditions.
